

# 9 principles for effective design

### 1) KISS (Keep It Simple Stupid)

Avoid clutter and embrace white space.

### 2) Use a grid

Establishes structure, alignment and organization.

# 3) Generally use no more than two typefaces / fonts

Provide basic spatial arrangement of copy, headlines, and photos.

### 4) Use a hierarchal system of design

Lay out a page by order of item importance.

### 5) Lead the eye

Eye directional movement on a page should flow from top to bottom, left to right.

## 6) White space / negative space

Creates harmony, balance, and helps to brand a design, it can also lead a reader from one element to another.

# 7) Use design elements effectively to present message

Bullets, squares, circles, diamonds, lines, shapes, screened boxes, etc.

### 8) Rule of thirds

Helps launch your design composition and gives you a quick guide to position and frame your elements.

### 9) CRAP (Contrast Repetition Alignment Proximity)

The four key principles of visual design that have an important impact on usability.
